Children's Fairyland is 68 years old! I can take care of Fairyland by using extra gentle hands when I touch things.






A lot of children like playing at Fairyland. Sometimes it can be loud, and I might feel ______ I can tell my adult when I need a break.

I might want to go on rides at Fairyland. I will wait in line until it's my turn to have an adventure. The ride operator will check my height to make sure I'll feel safe.






On the rides, I keep my hands inside and follow the safety instructions so I can have fun without getting hurt.
